





## STATISTICAL YEARBOOK OF PORTUGAL: THE 2023 EDITION IS NOW AVAILABLE

The most recent *Statistical Yearbook of Portugal* is now available. A compendium of official statistical information that gathers in a single volume a multidimensional statistical portrait of the country in several analytical domains.

The information in the 2022 yearbook generally refers to data available on 15 June 2023. Each chapter presents a summarised statistical analysis and an infographics page, allowing a quick understanding of the phenomena under study.



### STATISTICAL YEARBOOK OF PORTUGAL NOW ON ITS 113<sup>TH</sup> EDITION

This is the 114th volume of a publication whose first edition dates 1877, with data referring to 1875.

It is organised into 30 chapters, divided into four main themes (territory, people, economic activity, and state), with information generally based on data available on 15 June 2023.

In this edition, each chapter includes a short statistical analysis and a series of infographics, which allow a quick analysis of demographic, social and economic phenomena.

This yearbook is a bilingual edition (Portuguese and English), published on paper and available electronically on the Statistics Portugal website ([www.ine.pt](http://www.ine.pt)) in .pdf format (analyses and infographics), accompanied by the corresponding statistical tables (in .xlsx and .csv formats) with extended time series and geographical disaggregation at NUTS I and II levels, allowing greater chronological and geographical comparability.

Most indicators in each chapter have a hyperlink to Statistics Portugal's dissemination database, which is regularly updated. Therefore, when a new consultation is made, the user will always have access to the most recent data from Statistics Portugal. The link also makes it possible to consult the corresponding metadata.

Statistics Portugal offers its yearbook to municipal and school (public and private, secondary and university) libraries nationwide to promote citizenship and statistical literacy among citizens and students.
