Portuguese Life Tables 2005 - 2007

Complete life Table for Portugal 2005 – 2007

Statistics Portugal releases the 2005 – 2007 Complete Life Tables for Portugal.

Statistics Portugal releases the 2005 - 2007 national complete life tables. The final official values of the life expectancy for 2005 – 2007 are made available and replace the provisory values published in February 2008.

Life expectancy at birth for both males and females was 78.48 years. Men and women could expect on average to live to 75.18 years and 81.57 years of age respectively.

Life expectancy at age 65 has reached 17,99. Men aged 65 could expect to live a further 16.07 years and women a further 19.48 years if mortality rates remained the same as they were in 2005-07.
