## Tourist Demand of Residents 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter 2013

## Trips made by residents in Portugal still growing but mainly with short duration

In the  $3^{rd}$  quarter 2013, Portuguese residents made 6.35 million tourism trips, 7.4% more than in the  $3^{rd}$  quarter 2012<sup>1</sup> (+7.0% in the  $2^{nd}$  quarter 2013). Short duration trips (up to 3 nights) raised 11.1%, weighting 53.4% of the total (1.8 p.p. more than in the  $3^{rd}$  quarter 2012).

Although the main motivation to travel was "leisure, recreation or holiday", in close connection with the summer period, the emphasis went to "visit to relatives or friends", with a 21.7% growth in the number of trips made, surpassing a third the total of trips in the  $3^{rd}$  quarter.

"Free private accommodation" was chosen in 72.8% of all tourist overnight stays and the "private car" was the elected means of transport in 85.5% of all tourism trips.
