## Air transport maintains acceleration

## Movement of goods with reduction in rail and deceleration in ports and road transport

In the  $2^{nd}$  quarter 2017, the movement of passengers in national airports grew by  $20.6\%^1$ , above the 18.6% growth recorded in the preceding quarter. Heavy rail and light railway also registered increases in passengers carried: 6.6% and 3.7%, respectively (+6.2% and +12.4% in the  $1^{st}$  Q 2017).

The movement of goods in national ports recorded an increase of 2.0%, after the growth of 11.1% in the preceding quarter.

The road freight transport registered a less marked growth in the  $2^{nd}$  quarter 2017 (+4.3%) comparatively with the previous quarter (+11.6%) in terms of tonnes transported. This growth continued to be supported by the increase of national transport (+6.3%), while international transport decreased (-4.7%).

The transport of goods by railway decreased (-5.7% in tonnes and -3.1% in tonnes-kilometer) after a slight increase of 0.6% in tonnes of goods transported in the  $1^{st}$  Q 2017.
