International Trade Statistics May 2020

Exports and imports of goods decreased by 39.0% and by 40.2% respectively, in nominal terms

In **May 2020**, exports and imports of goods recorded nominal year-on-year growth rates of -39.0% and -40.2%, respectively (-40.1% and -39.5% in April 2020, in the same order). All the product categories showed significant decreases, with exports and imports of *Transport equipment* standing out (-54.0% and -66.6%, respectively).

Excluding *Fuels and lubricants*, exports and imports decreased by 35.2% and by 35.1%, respectively (-39.2% and -38.3%, in the same order, in April 2020).

The deficit on the balance of trade in goods decreased by EUR 722 million when compared to the same month of 2019, reaching EUR 908 million in **May 2020**. Excluding *Fuels and lubricants*, the trade balance stood at EUR -778 million, corresponding to a decrease of EUR 420 million in the trade deficit vis-à-vis May 2019.

In the **quarter ended in May 2020**, exports and imports of goods decreased by 30.8% and by 30.6% respectively, compared to the quarter ended in May 2019 (-17.7% and -16.7% in the same order, in the quarter ended in April 2020).

The information in this press release, regarding May, reflects the effects of the COVID-19 pandemic in both the performance of the economic activity and the quantity of primary information available in the compilation of the results presented. Despite the difficulties, we call for the best collaboration by firms, households, and public entities in answering the requests of Statistics Portugal to obtain information. The quality of official statistics, especially its capacity to identify the impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic, depends crucially on this collaboration that Statistics Portugal is grateful for in advance.

GLOBAL RESULTS

In May 2020, as regards **year-on-year rates of change**, exports decreased by 39.0% (-40.1% in April 2020) and imports fell by 40.2% (-39.5% in April 2020) in both cases due to the decreases in Intra-EU and Extra-EU trade. All product categories decreased with the emphasis on the declines in exports and imports of *Transport equipment* (-54.0% and -66.6%, respectively).

Excluding *Fuels and lubricants*, in year-on-year terms, **in May 2020** exports decreased by 35.2% and imports declined by 35.1% (-39.2% and -38.3% respectively, in April 2020).


In May 2020, vis-à-vis the preceding month, exports and imports increased by 14.4% and by 5.2%, respectively (-33.7% and -32.5% in the same order, in April 2020).

In the quarter ended in May 2020, exports and imports of goods decreased by 30.8% and by 30.6% respectively, when compared to the quarter ended in May 2019 (-17.7% and -16.7% in the same order, in the quarter ended in April 2020).













In May 2020, the **deficit of trade balance** amounted to EUR 908 million, which stood for a decrease of EUR 722 million in the deficit when compared to the same month of 2019.

Excluding *Fuels and lubricants*, **in May 2020**, the trade balance stood at EUR -778 million, corresponding to a decrease of EUR 420 million in the trade deficit vis-à-vis May 2019.

BROAD ECONOMIC CATEGORIES

In **May 2020**, when compared to the same month of 2019, all the broad economic categories recorded decreases in both flows. Particularly noteworthy, in terms of **exports**, were the decreases in *Transport equipment* (-54.0%, mainly to Spain and Germany) and *Industrial supplies* (-33.5%, mainly to Spain). As far as **imports** are concerned, the emphasis was on the decreases in *Transport equipment* (-66.6%, mainly from France), *Fuels and lubricants* (-78.7%) mostly due to the closure of the national refineries, and *Industrial supplies* (-32.6%, mostly from Spain).

MAIN PARTNER COUNTRIES/SUPPLIERS

In **May 2020**, when considering the main partner countries in 2019, concerning **exports**, there were decreases in all the main partners when compared to May 2019, more so towards Spain (-41.2%), mainly due to the decreases in exports of *Industrial supplies*, *Consumption goods* and *Transport equipment*. In terms of **imports**, the emphasis was likewise on the decrease from Spain (-31.3%), mainly due to *Industrial supplies*. Only China recorded an increase (+5.1%) due to *Consumption goods*, mostly originated in imports of individual protective equipment (mainly masks).

EXPLANATORY NOTES

- 1. International Trade compiles the statistical information about the commercial trade of goods with the European Union (Intra-EU trade) and Third Countries (Extra-EU trade). In terms of Intra-EU trade statistics it includes adjustments for non-responses as well as for enterprises with transactions below the defined exemption thresholds (which exempts from providing statistical data a significant number of enterprises). Since February 2020, the United Kingdom is already considered a Third Country. In this press release, for comparison purposes, in the analyses vis-à-vis the same month of the previous year or with the previous month the United Kingdom is considered as a Third Country in these periods.
- **2.** For simplification purposes, the terms associated to International Trade Statistics are narrowed to "imports" and "exports", however stating which market is being referred to (Intra-EU, Extra-EU and International Trade which includes the former two).

In this "Press Release" the following statistical data are used:

2016: Intra-UE trade - January to December definitive results;

Extra-UE trade - January to December definitive results.

2017: Intra-EU trade - January to December definitive results;

Extra-EU trade - January to December definitive results.

2018: Intra-EU trade - January to December definitive results;

Extra-EU trade - January to December definitive results.

2019: Intra-EU trade - January to December preliminary results;

Extra-EU trade - January to December preliminary results.


2020: Intra-EU trade - January to May monthly preliminary results;

Extra-EU trade – January to May monthly preliminary results.

- **3.** Due to rounding of numbers, totals might not correspond to the sum of the indicated parcels.
- **4.** Month-to-month growth rate it compares the level of each variable between two consecutive months. Although it allows an up to date follow-up of the evolution of each variable, the value of this variation is particularly influenced by seasonal fluctuations effects and from other specific effects in one or both compared months.
- **5.** Year-on-year growth rate it compares the level of each variable between the current period and the same period of the previous year. Its evolution is less biased from seasonal fluctuations, however, it might be influenced by this type of effects located in a specific period compared.
- **6.** Response rate: this press release includes information from customs (Extra-EU trade) and responses from enterprises to the Intrastat (Intra-EU trade). It is noted that in the current context of the COVID-19 pandemic, the response rates in Intrastat may be lower than the usual pattern. In fact, the response rates observed for the May 2020 reference data were, in exports, 77% in number of enterprises and 92% in value and, in imports, 75% and 92%, respectively, corresponding to around 1 to 5 p.p. below the response rates underlying the same May 2019 data release.

- **8.** The BEC nomenclature Classification by Broad Economic Categories doesn't include the *Gold for monetary use* (CN 71082000) and *Coins, including coins with legal tender (except medals, coins mounted in objects of personal adornment coins with character collectibles with numismatic value, waste and scrap) (CN 71189000). The sum of the various categories of the BEC may not match with total trade, due to these exclusions and also for confidentiality reasons.*
- **9.** Intra-EU trade concerning Euro Zone includes, since 2017, stores and provisions within the framework of Intra-EU trade, which in the previous years are included in non-Euro Zone. However, given the slight weight (lower than 0.1%) in total trade, data are comparable for the all series available.
- 10. Unit Value Indices for International Trade in Goods

The starting Universe corresponds to International Trade in Goods, set on a 40 days basis for the reference month, with the most up to date results at that moment for both periods (month and month-on-month). Definitive results for 2012 to 2017 and preliminary results for 2018 to 2020 are used for the calculation of Quarterly Indices. The monthly indices are consistent with the quarterly indices (40 days), by applying the Chow-Lin method.

For the purposes of calculating the Unit Value Indices, there are some exclusions in International Trade to be considered, with a low significance in total values, namely transactions with a statistical value lesser than EUR 1 000 and according to the number of observations by enterprise/Economic Area/CN8, Chapters 98 and 99 of the CN and records with a net mass of less than 0.5 kg. However, the representativeness of the sample in each product group is guaranteed, reaching a total coverage of more than 80%.

The unit value indices are calculated at the most detailed level of information (CN8, around 9 500 codes), and aggregated as *Paasche* indices (price) by CPA (Statistical Classification of Products by Activity) for the quarterly indices. Monthly indices are disseminated only for total and total excluding petroleum products. They indicate the change over the same period of the previous year. It is also important to mention that these indices correspond to unit value indices rather than real effective price indices, thus reflecting apart from the changes in prices, also the changes in the composition and in the quality of the goods considered at the most detailed level of information.





The dissemination of the quarterly indices is ensured in the usual International Trade Statistics press release, according to the following calendar:
