Exports and imports of goods decreased by 10.1% and by 23.1% respectively, in nominal terms

In **June 2020**, exports and imports of goods recorded nominal year-on-year growth rates of -10.1% and -23.1%, respectively (-38.7% and -39.8% in May 2020, in the same order). Most product categories decreased, with the emphasis on the declines in exports of *Industrial supplies* (-13.0%) and imports of *Transport equipment* and *Fuels and lubricants* (-49.4% and -65.5%, respectively).

Excluding *Fuels and lubricants*, exports and imports decreased by 7.6% and by 17.2%, respectively (-34.8% and -34.7%, in the same order, in May 2020).

The deficit on the balance of trade in goods decreased by EUR 1,049 million when compared to the same month of 2019, reaching EUR 828 million in **June 2020**. Excluding *Fuels and lubricants*, the trade balance stood at EUR -665 million, corresponding to a decrease of EUR 664 million in the trade deficit vis-à-vis June 2019.

In the 2^{nd} quarter of 2020, exports and imports of goods decreased by 30.6% and by 34.4% respectively, when compared to the 2^{nd} quarter of 2019 (-31.0% and -30.7% in the same order, in the quarter ended in May 2020).

In the $\mathbf{1}^{\text{st}}$ half of $\mathbf{2020}$, there were decreases of 17.1% in exports and 19.7% in imports, which stands for a reversal of the growth trend registered in both flows in the 2^{nd} half of 2019 (+4.0% and +4.3%, in the same order). Excluding *Fuels and lubricants*, the decreases were 16.5% and 18.2%, respectively (+4.2 and +5.3%, in the 2^{nd} half of 2019).

The information in this press release, regarding June, reflects the effects of the COVID-19 pandemic in both the performance of the economic activity and the quantity of primary information available in the compilation of the results presented. Despite the difficulties, we call for the best collaboration by enterprises, households, and public entities in answering the requests of Statistics Portugal to obtain information. The quality of official statistics, especially its capacity to identify the impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic, depends crucially on this collaboration for which Statistics Portugal is grateful for in advance.

GLOBAL RESULTS

In June 2020, as regards **year-on-year rates of change**, exports decreased by 10.1% (-38.7% in May 2020) and imports fell by 23.1% (-39.8% in May 2020) in both cases due to the decreases in Intra-EU and Extra-EU trade. Most product categories decreased, with the emphasis on the declines in exports of *Industrial supplies* (-13.0%) and imports of *Transport equipment* and *Fuels and lubricants* (-49.4% and -65.5%, respectively). In part, the lesser extent of the reduction observed in both trade flows reflected a calendar effect (June 2020 had two more working days than June 2019). The year-on-year growth rates in June were also affected by a base effect, since there was a very high volume of imports in the same month of the previous year, when there were significant imports of *Transport equipment* and a very small volume of exports, mainly in *Fuels and lubricants*.

International Trade Statistics – June 2020



Excluding *Fuels and lubricants*, in year-on-year terms, **in June 2020**, exports and imports decreased by 7.6% and by 17.2%, respectively (-34.8% and -34.7% in the same order, in May 2020).

In June 2020, vis-à-vis the preceding month, exports and imports increased by 24.2% and by 17.0%, respectively (+16.6% and +6.5% in the same order, in May 2020).

In the 2nd quarter of 2020, exports and imports of goods decreased by 30.6% and by 34.4% respectively, when compared to the 2nd quarter of 2019 (-31.0% and -30.7% in the same order, in the quarter ended in May 2020).


In the 1^{st} half of 2020, there were decreases of 17.1% in exports and 19.7% in imports, which represents a reversal of the growth trend registered in both flows in the 2^{nd} half of 2019 (+4.0% and +4.3%, in the same order). 







In June 2020, the **deficit of trade balance** amounted to EUR 828 million, which stood for a decrease of EUR 1,049 million in the deficit when compared to the same month of 2019.

Excluding *Fuels and lubricants*, in June 2020, the trade balance stood at EUR -665 million, corresponding to a decrease of EUR 664 million in the trade deficit vis-à-vis June 2019.

BROAD ECONOMIC CATEGORIES

In **June 2020**, when compared to the same month of 2019, almost all the broad economic categories recorded decreases in both flows. Concerning **exports**, the emphasis was on the decreases in *Industrial supplies* (-13.0%, mainly to Spain and Germany) and the increases of *Capital goods* (+3.5%, mostly to Germany) and *Food and beverages* (+4.6%, mostly to Spain and the United Kingdom). As far as **imports** are concerned, the decreases in *Transport equipment* (-49.4%, mainly from France) and *Fuels and lubricants* (-65.5%), mostly due to the closure of the national refineries in the most critical months of the COVID-19 pandemic, stood out.

MAIN PARTNER COUNTRIES/SUPPLIERS

In **June 2020**, when considering the main partner countries in 2019, concerning **exports**, there were decreases in all the main partners when compared to June 2019, more so towards Spain (-7.3%), due to the decreases in exports of *Industrial supplies, Consumer goods*, and *Fuels and lubricants*. In terms of **imports**, the emphasis was on the decrease from France (-55.0%), mostly due to *Other transport equipment* (airplanes). The only increases were registered in imports from China (due to the increase in *Consumer goods*, mostly originated in imports of personal protective equipment – mainly masks, and the increase in *Capital goods*) and in imports from the Netherlands (+20.5% and +4.7%, respectively).

EXPLANATORY NOTES

- 1. International Trade compiles the statistical information about the commercial trade of goods with the European Union (Intra-EU trade) and Third Countries (Extra-EU trade). In terms of Intra-EU trade statistics it includes adjustments for non-responses as well as for enterprises with transactions below the defined exemption thresholds (which exempts from providing statistical data a significant number of enterprises). Since February 2020, the United Kingdom is already considered a Third Country. In this press release, for comparison purposes, in the analyses vis-à-vis the same month of the previous year or with the previous month the United Kingdom is considered as a Third Country in these periods.
- For simplification purposes, the terms associated to International Trade Statistics are narrowed to "imports" and "exports", however stating which market is being referred to (Intra-EU, Extra-EU and International Trade which includes the former two).

In this "Press Release" the following statistical data are used:

2016: Intra-EU trade - January to December definitive results;

Extra-EU trade - January to December definitive results.

2017: Intra-EU trade - January to December definitive results;

Extra-EU trade - January to December definitive results.

2018: Intra-EU trade - January to December definitive results;

Extra-EU trade - January to December definitive results.

2019: Intra-EU trade - January to December preliminary results;

Extra-EU trade - January to December preliminary results. 2020: Intra-EU trade - January to June monthly preliminary results;

Extra-EU trade - January to June monthly preliminary results.

- Due to rounding of numbers, totals might not correspond to the sum of the indicated parcels.
- Month-to-month growth rate it compares the level of each variable between two consecutive months. Although it allows an up to date follow-up of the evolution of each variable, the value of this variation is particularly influenced by seasonal fluctuations effects and from other specific effects in one or both compared months.
- 5. Year-on-year growth rate it compares the level of each variable between the current period and the same period of the previous year. Its evolution is less biased from seasonal fluctuations, however, it might be influenced by this type of effects located in a specific period compared.
- 6. Response rate: this press release includes information from customs (Extra-EU trade) and responses from enterprises to the Intrastat (Intra-EU trade). It is noted that in the current context of the COVID-19 pandemic, the response rates in Intrastat may be lower than the usual pattern. In fact, the response rates observed for the June 2020 reference data were, in exports, 80% in number of enterprises and 92% in value and, in imports, 77% and 92%, respectively, corresponding to around 2 to 5 p.p. below the response rates underlying the same June 2019 data release.







7. Revisions: the revisions policy applied to International Trade statistics has been changed since the May 2019 edition of this press release in order to anticipate the dissemination of definitive results (8 months earlier than in the previous revisions policy). Therefore, in each month the information regarding month m (on a 40 days basis) is published and the previous four months are revised. The preliminary results for 2019 were available in June 2020, that is, at the last (fourth) revision in December. The release of definitive results for 2019 will take place in September 2020. The information released monthly contains routine revisions due to the replacement of estimations by new data received in the meantime, and, to a lesser extent, the replacement of values previously reported by corrections reported by the enterprises. The following table shows the impact of those revisions on the year-on-year rate of change (three months) disseminated in the previous press release:

The starting Universe corresponds to International Trade in Goods, set on a 40 days basis for the reference month, with the most up to date results at that moment for both periods (month and month-on-month). Definitive results for 2012 to 2017 and preliminary results for 2018 to 2020 are used for the calculation of Quarterly Indices. The monthly indices are consistent with the quarterly indices (40 days), by applying the Chow-Lin method.

For the purposes of calculating the Unit Value Indices, there are some exclusions in International Trade to be considered, with a low significance in total values, namely transactions with a statistical value lesser than EUR 1 000 and according to the number of observations by enterprise/Economic Area/CN8, Chapters 98 and 99 of the CN and records with a net mass of less than 0.5 kg. However, the representativeness of the sample in each product group is guaranteed, reaching a total coverage of more than 80%.

The unit value indices are calculated at the most detailed level of information (CN8, around 9 500 codes), and aggregated as *Paasche* indices (price) by CPA (Statistical Classification of Products by Activity) for the quarterly indices. Monthly indices are disseminated only for total and total excluding petroleum products. They indicate the change over the same period of the previous year. It is also important to mention that these indices correspond to unit value indices rather than real effective price indices, thus reflecting apart from the changes in prices, also the changes in the composition and in the quality of the goods considered at the most detailed level of information.
