

## Industrial Production Statistics 2019

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### Industrial production continued to decelerate in 2019

In 2019, total sales of products and services in the industry reached EUR 94.1 billion, representing a nominal increase of 2.7% over the previous year (+7.1% in 2018).

The activities that recorded the most significant positive contributions to growth registered in the total industry were Manufacture of motor vehicles and Food industries, with +1.5 p.p. and +0.4 p.p., respectively.

Divisions 10, Food industries and 29, Manufacture of motor vehicles with trailers, semi-trailers and components for motor vehicles, presented the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> highest weights in total sales and services, totalling EUR 11.9 billion and EUR 11.7 billion, respectively. Both divisions recorded positive changes, of 3.2% and 13.0%, respectively (+3.9% and +33.3% in the same order, in 2018).

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The publication "[Industrial Production Statistics 2019](#)", published today, disseminates the main statistical data on the Portuguese industrial production in 2019, obtained from the Annual Survey on Industrial Production (Prodcom Survey).

### Methodological note:

The Annual Survey on Industrial Production (Prodcom survey), transposes, in full, the European methodology for industrial production statistics, from the Council's regulation 3924/91, of 19.12.1992 (PRODCOM Regulation) and the Commission's regulation 912/2004, of 29.04.2004, in respect to the coverage of industrial production, inquired variables and types of production.

These regulation's methodology was adapted to the Portuguese industrial reality, by breaking down the EU list of products and adopting national sub-positions, considered to be indispensable for the adequate knowledge of the national industrial production.
