## DEATHS, LIVE BIRTHS AND MARRIAGES

### THE NUMBER OF LIVE BIRTHS REGISTERED IN MARCH 2025 INCREASED 1.6% COMPARED TO THE SAME MONTH OF 2024

In April 2025, there were 9,737 deaths, 1,328 less (-12.0%) than in the previous month. Compared to the same month of 2024, there was an increase of 148 deaths (+1.5%). The number of deaths of children under 1 year of age was 13 (17 in the same month of 2024).

In March 2025, 6,936 live births were registered, 633 more (+10.0%) compared to February 2025 and 106 more (+1.6%) compared to the same month of 2024.

In March 2025, the natural balance was -4,114<sup>1</sup>, worsening in relation to the same month of 2024, when it reached -3,732.

In March 2025, 1,947 marriages were celebrated, 282 more (+16.9%) than in February 2025 and eight less (-0.4%) than in March 2024.

In this press release, Statistics Portugal provides **preliminary data** on the number of deaths per month until April 2025<sup>2</sup>, and the number of live births and marriages per month until March 2025, that occurred in the national territory. The indicators published and analyzed are available on the Official Statistics Portal ([www.ine.pt](http://www.ine.pt)), with geographical breakdowns NUTS 2 and NUTS 3. The hyperlinks to these statistics can be found in the Excel file published together with this Press Release. The information is obtained from the Sistema Integrado do Registo e Identificação Civil (SIRIC) until May 9<sup>th</sup>, 2025.

<sup>1</sup> The natural balance is calculated based on the difference between the number of live births of mothers residing in Portugal and the number of deaths of residents in Portugal.

<sup>2</sup> After the release of mortality data for 2022 and considering the decrease of the impact of deaths due to COVID-19 on mortality, the analysis regarding the number of deaths per week was suspended. However, the release of indicators regarding the number of weekly deaths, by NUTS 3 breakdown, until the 18<sup>th</sup> week of 2025, and daily deaths, by NUTS 2 breakdown, until May 4<sup>th</sup>, 2025, is assured.



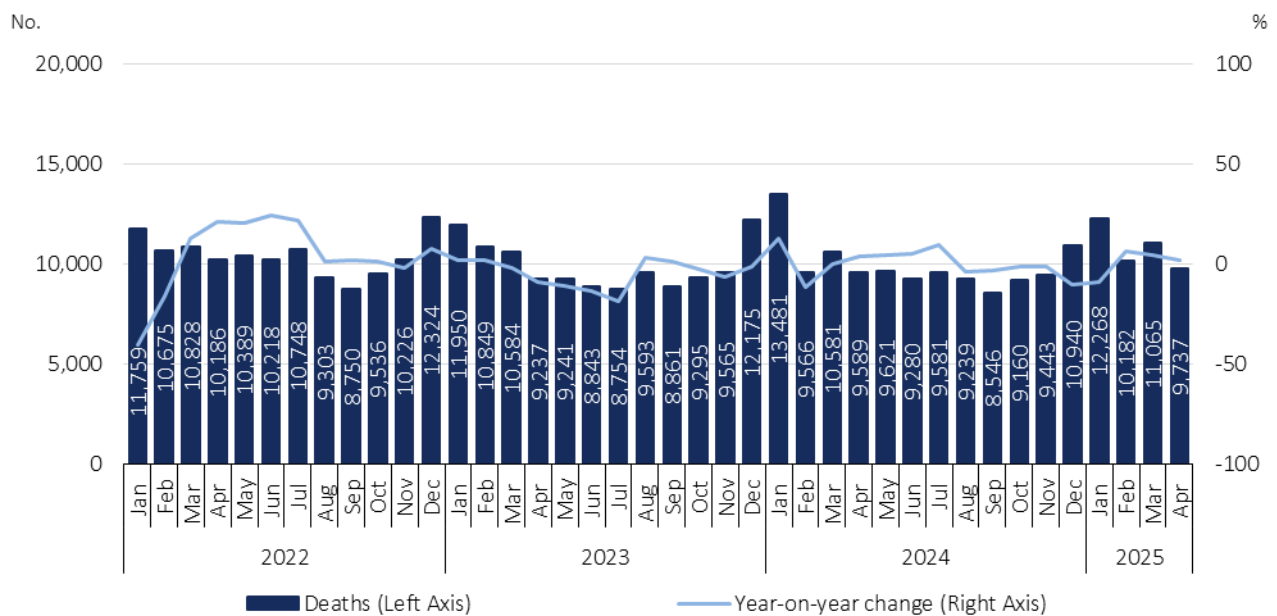
In April 2025, the number of deaths increased 1.5% compared to the same month of 2024

In April 2025, there were 9,737 deaths (of which 53 were from residents abroad), 1,328 less (-12.0%) than in the previous month. Compared to the same month of 2024, there was an increase of 148 deaths (+1.5%).

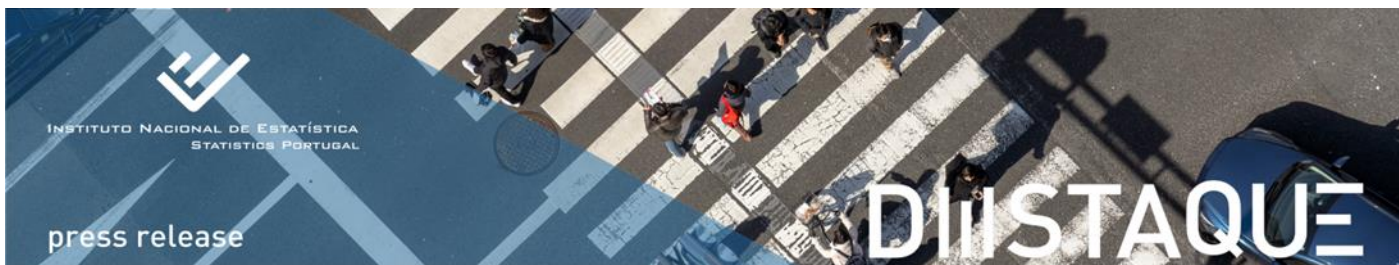
In that month, the number of deaths of children under 1 year old was 13 (all of them born to mothers residing in Portugal), two less than in the previous month and four less compared with the same month of 2024.

In the first four months of the year, there were 43,252 deaths in national territory (35 more than in the same period of 2024), of which 67 were deaths of children under 1 year of age (86 in 2024).

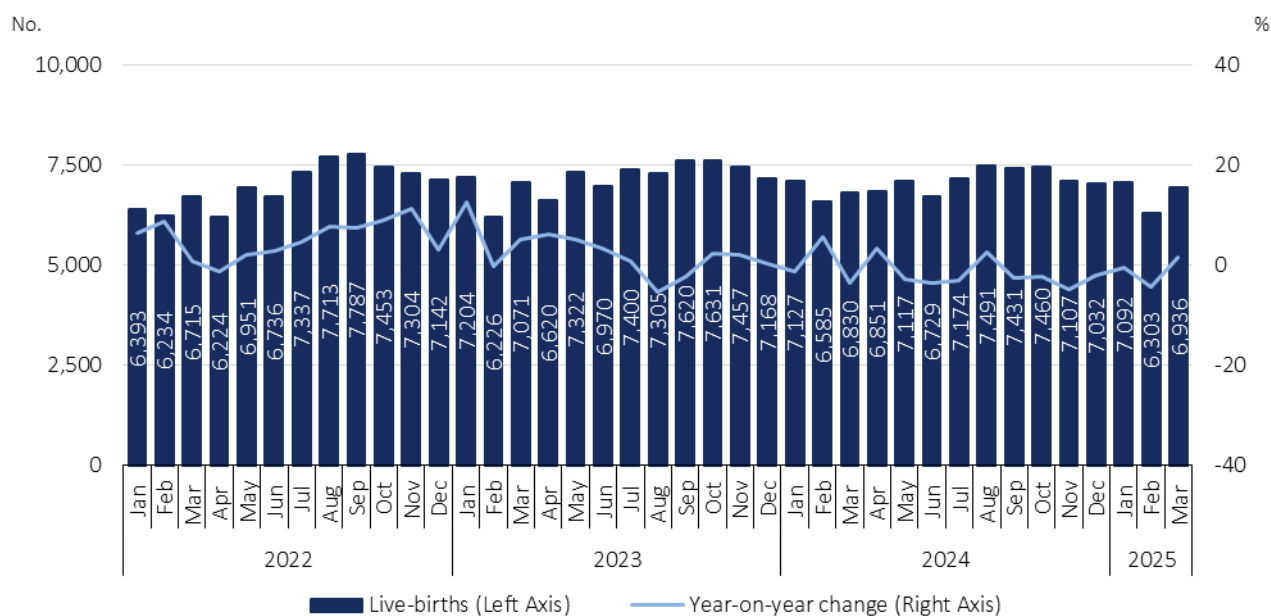


In March 2025, the number of live births increased 1.6% compared to March 2024

In March 2025, there were 6,936 live births (of which 24 were born to mothers residing abroad), corresponding to an increase of 10.0% (633 more) compared to February 2025 and of 1.6% (106 more) compared to the same month of 2024.

In the first quarter of the year, 20,331 live births were registered in the country (211 less than in the same period of 2024), of which 57 were born to mothers residing abroad (90 in 2024).

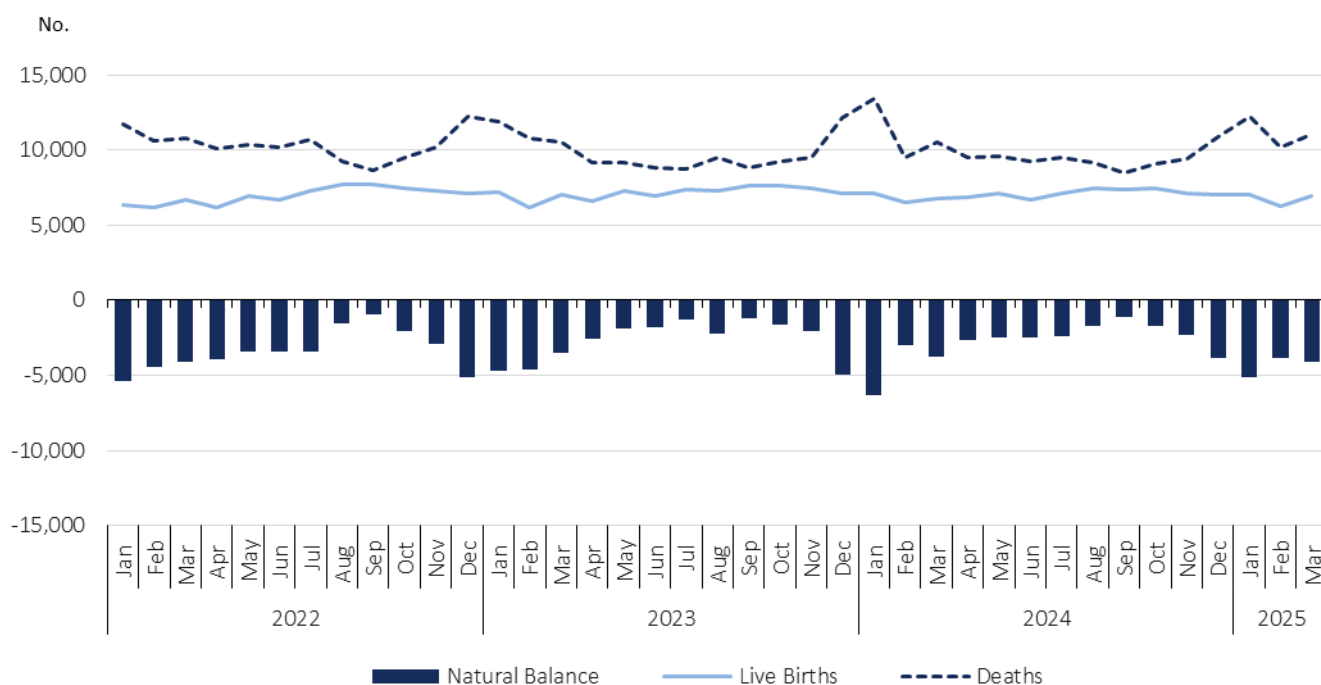


### Natural balance of -4,114 in March 2025

In March 2025, the natural balance registered the value of -4,114, worsening compared to the figure of February 2025 (-3,858) and compared to that of the same month of 2024 (-3,732).

In the first quarter of the year, the cumulative value of the natural balance was -13,127, slightly worsening in relation to that registered in the same period of 2024 (-13,039).

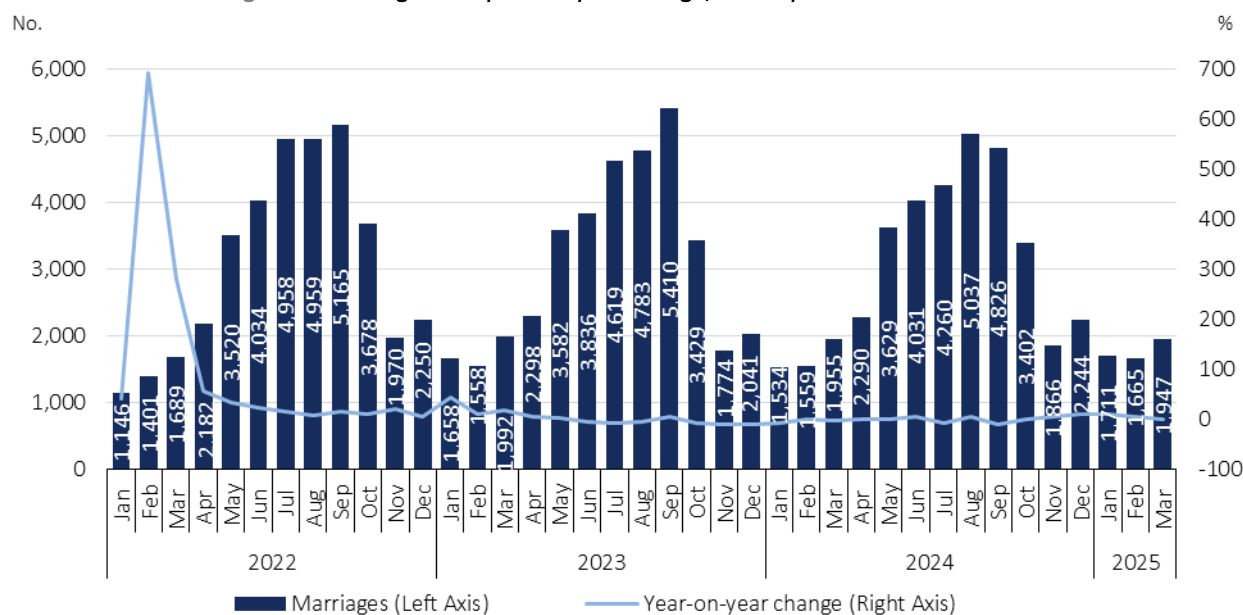

In March 2025, the number of celebrated marriages decreased 0.4% compared to March 2024

In March 2025, 1,947 marriages were celebrated, higher than the number registered in February 2025 (282 more; +16.9%), but lower than that registered in March 2024 (eight less; -0.4%).

In the first quarter of 2025, 5,323 marriages were celebrated, 275 more (+5.4%) than in the same period of 2024.

## TECHNICAL NOTE

Statistics Portugal releases the **preliminary** monthly **numbers** of deaths, live births, and marriages based on the information registered in the Civil Register Offices until May 9<sup>th</sup>, 2025. Indicators on the preliminary monthly number of live births, deaths, and marriages, from January 2025 to March 2025, with geographical breakdowns up to NUTS 3, by NUTS 2024, as well as weekly number of deaths, until the 18<sup>th</sup> week 2025, by NUTS 3 and daily number of deaths, until May 4<sup>th</sup>, 2025, by NUTS 2 are made available on the Statistics Portugal Website.

Data are obtained from statistical operations of direct and exhaustive collection on live births, deaths and marriages in Portuguese territory using facts that are subject to compulsory civil registration (birth and death) in the Sistema Integrado do Registo e Identificação Civil (SIRIC).

In addition to administrative information obtained from Civil Register Offices, Statistics Portugal collects an additional set of variables identified as statistically pertinent to the National Statistic System (NSS) and the European Statistical System (EES). Data is recorded and sent electronically, in compliance with the requirements set out by Statistics Portugal and laid down in liaison with the Instituto de Registos e Notariado (IRN) and the Instituto de Gestão Financeira e Equipamentos da Justiça (IGFEJ).

## DEFINITIONS

**Marriage:** Contract signed by two persons that intend to start a family in full partnership and cohabitation according to legislation. Note: marriage can be held between persons from different or same sex.

**Live birth:** This is the complete expulsion or extraction from the mother's body, irrespective of the duration of the pregnancy, of a product of fertilization that, after separation, breathes or shows any other signs of life, such as a beating of the heart or umbilical cord or actual contraction of any muscle subject to voluntary movement, whether the umbilical cord has been severed and whether the placenta is retained.

**Death:** The permanent disappearance of vital functions.

**Natural balance:** The difference between the number of live births and the number of deaths during a given period.

**Year-on-year change:** The year-on-year change compares the level of a variable between the reference month and the same month of the previous year.
