Retail Trade Turnover, Employment, Wages and Salaries and Hours worked Indices March 2013

Retail Trade Turnover index with a more negative year-on-year change rate

The retail trade turnover index (seasonally adjusted and at constant prices) registered a year-on-year change rate of -6.0% in March 2013 (-5.3% in February). In the 1st quarter 2013, the year-on-year change rate stood at -5.1% (-7.2% in the 4th quarter 2012). In March, the year-on-year change rates of the indices of employment, of the number of hours worked adjusted for working days and of wages and salaries were -5.6%, -5.9% and -5,3%, respectively (-5.6%, -6.5% and -7,4% in February, by the same order).
