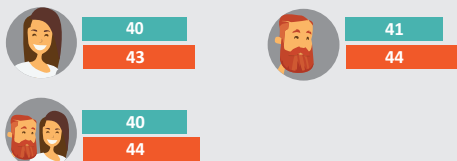

Employed population by sex



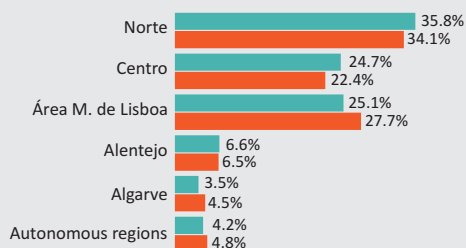

Employed population by region of work



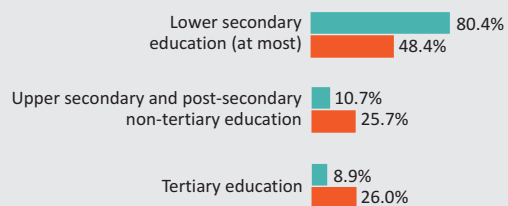

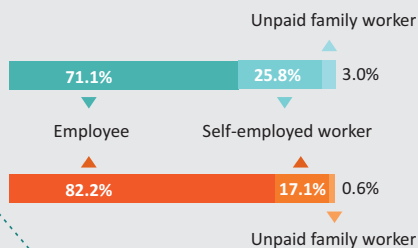

Employed population by highest completed level of education



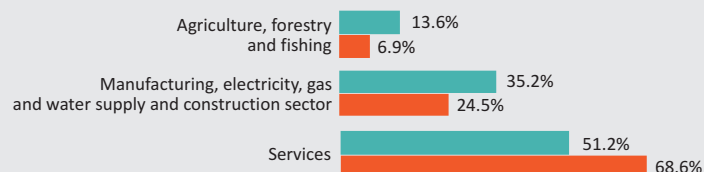

Employed population by professional status



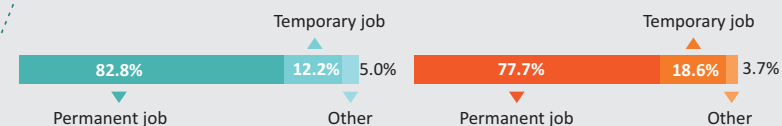
WORKS IN THE SERVICES SECTOR

Employed population by activity sector



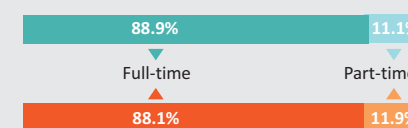
HAS A PERMANENT JOB

Employed population by work duration regime



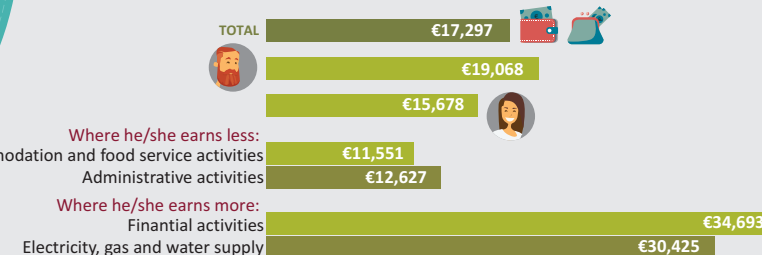

Full-time workers by sex and usual weekly hours of work



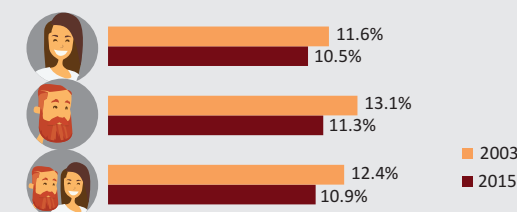
