June 2018

Exports and imports increased by 8.6% and by 18.1% respectively, in nominal terms

In **June 2018**, exports and imports of goods recorded year-on-year nominal growth rates of +8.6% and +18.1% respectively, both accelerating when compared with the previous month (+6.2% and +0.6% in May 2018, in the same order). The noteworthy increase in imports was mainly due to *Fuels and lubricants* from Extra-EU countries. Excluding *Fuels and lubricants*, exports increased by 6.8% and imports grew by 10.3% (+4.4% and +2.5% respectively in May 2018).

The deficit of trade balance amounted to EUR 1,682 million in **June 2018**, increasing by EUR 641 million when compared with the same month of 2017. Excluding *Fuels and lubricants*, the trade balance stood at EUR -999 million, corresponding to an increase of EUR 231 million in the trade deficit when compared with June 2017.

In the **2nd quarter 2018**, exports and imports of goods grew by 10.5% and 10.4% respectively, vis-à-vis the same period of the previous year.

In **the first half of 2018**, the increases of 6.6% in exports and 8.8% in imports stood for a significant deceleration when compared with the same period of 2017 (+12.2% and +14.3% respectively in the first half of 2017). Excluding *Fuels and lubricants* there were increases of 6.4% and 8.0% respectively (+10.2% and +11.4% in the first half of 2017).

GLOBAL RESULTS

In June 2018, as regards year-on-year rates of change, exports increased by 8.6% (+6.2% in May 2018), mostly due to the 9.7% increase in the Intra-EU trade (+8.8% in May 2018). Imports increased by 18.1% (+0.6% in May 2018), as a result of the evolution in both types of trade: +45.7% in Extra-EU trade (-11.9% in May 2018) and +10.0% in Intra-EU trade (+4.8% in May 2018). The increase recorded in imports was mainly due to the steep growth of *Fuels and lubricants* from Extra-EU countries.

Excluding *Fuels and lubricants*, in year-on-year terms, **in June 2018** exports increased by 6.8% and imports grew by 10.3% (+4.4% and +2.5% respectively, in May 2018).

In June 2018, vis-à-vis the preceding month, exports decreased by 0.3% and imports increased by 8.3% (+6.8% and +2.8% respectively in May 2018), mirroring the variations of Extra-EU trade in both flows, given that in Intra-EU trade there were nil rate changes vis-à-vis the previous month.




In the 2nd quarter 2018, exports and imports grew by 10.5% and 10.4% respectively, vis-à-vis the 2nd quarter 2017 (+5.2% and +5.0%, in the same order, in the quarter ended in May 2018).

In **the first half of 2018**, the increases of 6.6% in exports and 8.8% in imports stood for a significant deceleration when compared with the same period of 2017 (+12.2% and +14.3% respectively in the first half of 2017). Excluding *Fuels and lubricants*, there were increases of 6.4% and 8.0% respectively (+10.2% and +11.4% in the first half of 2017).









In June 2018, the **deficit of trade balance** amounted to EUR 1,682 million, increasing by EUR 641 million when compared with the same month of 2017.

BROAD ECONOMIC CATEGORIES





In June 2018, when compared with the same month of 2017, all broad economic categories recorded increases in **exports**, more so in *Transport equipment* (+26.2%) and *Fuels and lubricants* (+36.9%). In **imports**, almost all broad

economic categories recorded increases, the largest one occurring in Fuels and lubricants (+92.8%), mostly due to imports of primary products in Extra-EU trade.

MAIN PARTNER COUNTRIES/SUPPLIERS

In **June 2018**, having in consideration the main destination countries in 2017, the emphasis was on the increases in **exports** to Spain, Germany and France (+7.6%, +15.9% and +7.9%, respectively) when compared with the same month of 2017. An emphasis should also be made on exports to Angola which have been recording successive declines throughout 2018, leading to a 15.5% decrease as regards the accumulated total in the first half of 2018 (vis-à-vis the same period of 2017).

In **June 2018**, as far as the main supplying countries in 2017 are concerned, all countries recorded increases, except for imports from Brazil which decreased by 58.9% in year-on-year terms. **Imports** from Germany and Spain recorded the largest increases (+19.5% and +5.3%, respectively).

EXPLANATORY NOTES

- 1. International Trade compiles the statistical information about the commercial trade of goods with the European Union (Intra-EU trade) and Third Countries (Extra-EU trade). In terms of Intra-EU trade statistics it includes adjustments for non-responses as well as for enterprises with transactions below the defined exemption thresholds (which exempts from providing statistical data a significant number of enterprises).
- **2.** For simplification purposes, the terms associated to International Trade Statistics are narrowed to "imports" and "exports", however stating which market is being referred to (Intra-EU, Extra-EU and International Trade which includes the former two).
- **3.** In this "Press Release" the following statistical data are used:
 - 2016: Intra-EU trade January to December definitive results;
 - Extra-EU trade January to December definitive results.
 - 2017: Intra-EU trade January to December preliminary results;
 - Extra-EU trade January to December preliminary results.
 - 2018: Intra-EU trade January to June monthly preliminary results;
 - Extra-EU trade January to June monthly preliminary results.
- **4.** Due to rounding of numbers, totals might not correspond to the sum of the indicated parcels.
- **5.** Month-to-month growth rate it compares the level of each variable between two consecutive months. Although being an indicator that allows an up to date follow-up of the evolution of each variable, the value of this variation rate is particularly influenced by seasonal fluctuations effects and from other specific effects in one or both compared months.
- **6.** Year-on-year growth rate it compares the level of each variable between the current period and the same period of the previous year. The evolution of this rate is less biased from seasonal fluctuations. However, it might be influenced by these types of effects when referred to a specific period of time.
- **7.** Revisions: data available in this press release include regular revisions of the previous three months (according to the Revisions Policy applicable for the International Trade in Goods statistics) due to the replacement of estimations by new data from the enterprises and, in a lesser dimension, due to the corrections in data made by the reporting enterprises. The following table shows the impact of those revisions in the year-on-year growth rate (three months) disseminated in the previous press release:

The BEC nomenclature - Classification by Broad Economic Categories doesn't include the *Gold for monetary use* (CN 71082000) and *Coins, including coins with legal tender (except medals, coins mounted in objects of personal adornment coins with character collectibles with numismatic value, waste and scrap) (CN 71189000). The sum of the various categories of the BEC may not match with total trade, due to these exclusions and also for confidentiality reasons.*







9. Unit Value Indices for International Trade in Goods

The monthly unit value indices for June 2018 can be consulted within two working days on Statistics Portugal Portal through the following links:

- Monthly unit value indices of exports (Month-on-month growth rate, price %)
- Monthly unit value indices of exports (Month-on-month growth rate, value %)
- Monthly unit value indices of exports (Month-on-month growth rate, volume %)

The starting Universe corresponds to International Trade in Goods, set on a 40 days basis for the reference month, with the most up to date results at that moment for both periods (month and month-on-month). Definitive results for 2014 and 2015 and preliminary results for 2016 to 2018 are used for the calculation of Quarterly Indices.

The monthly indices are consistent with the quarterly indices (40 days), by applying the Chow-Lin method.

For the purposes of calculating the Unit Value Indices, there are some exclusions in International Trade to be considered, with a low significance in total values, namely transactions with a statistical value lesser than EUR 1 000 and according to the number of observations by enterprise/Economic Area/CN8, Chapters 98 and 99 of the CN and records with a net mass of less than 0.5 kg. However, the representativeness of the sample in each product group is guaranteed, reaching a total coverage of more than 80%.

The unit value indices are calculated at the most detailed level of information (CN8, around 9 500 codes), and aggregated as *Paasche* indices (price) by CPA (Statistical Classification of Products by Activity) for the quarterly indices. Monthly indices are disseminated only for total and total excluding petroleum products. They indicate the change over the same period of the previous year. It is also important to mention that these indices correspond to unit value indices rather than real effective price indices, thus reflecting apart from the changes in prices, also the changes in the composition and in the quality of the goods considered at the most detailed level of information.
