

Purchasing Power Parities
2017

The per capita Gross Domestic Product (GDP-Pc) volume index, expressed in purchasing power parities, represented 76.6 % of the EU average in 2017, 0.6 percentage points lower than in 2016.

According to EUROSTAT, the Portuguese volume index of the GDP-Pc, expressed in purchasing power parities, represented 76.6% of the EU average (EU28=100) in 2017, a value lower to the observed in 2016 (77.2%).
