Construction: Building permits and completed buildings

1st Quarter 2019 – Preliminary data


Building permits increased by 10.7% and completed buildings grew by 7.2%

In the 1st quarter 2019, the number of building permits was 6.0 thousand, i.e. an increase of 10.7% compared to the same period of the previous year but slowing down vis-à-vis the 4th quarter 2018 (+28.1%). Building permits for new constructions increased by 11.7% and rehabilitation permits grew by 8.2%, both decelerating when compared to the growth rates recorded in the previous quarter (+28.8% and +22.2%, respectively). Completed buildings increased by 7.2% (+18.8% in the 4th quarter 2018) totalling 3.7 thousand buildings.

When compared to the previous quarter, the number of building permits increased by 6.0% (+5.0% in the 4th quarter 2018) and the number of completed buildings decreased by 8.2% (+4.8% in the 4th quarter 2018).

In the 1st quarter 2019, there were 6.0 thousand building permits and 3.7 thousand completed buildings in Portugal. Building permits increased by 10.7% vis-à-vis the 1st quarter 2018, corresponding to an increase of 6.0% when compared to the previous quarter. Completed buildings increased by 7.2% in year-on-year terms and decreased by 8.2% vis-à-vis the 4th quarter 2018. There was a deceleration in both cases compared to the year-on-year increases recorded in the previous quarter (+28.1% and +18.8%, respectively, in the 4th quarter 2018).

1. Building permits

In the 1^{st} quarter 2019, the number of building permits issued in Portugal was 6.0 thousand, corresponding to an increase of 10.7% vis-à-vis the 1^{st} quarter 2018 (+28.1% in the 4^{th} quarter 2018).

Of the overall building permits, 69.6% corresponded to new constructions and, of these, 75.9% referred to family housing. Demolished buildings (454 units) corresponded to 7.6% of the total building permits in the 1st quarter 2019.

The Região Autónoma dos Açores was the only region presenting a declining rate of change regarding the total number of building permits (-3.6%). The remaining regions presented positive rates of change compared to the same period a year earlier, more so the Região Autónoma da Madeira (+31.7%) and the Algarve (+31.2%).

The number of building permits for new constructions in Portugal increased by 11.7% vis-à-vis the 1st quarter 2018 and rehabilitation works grew by 8.2%. When compared to the previous quarter, permits for new constructions increased by 6.7% and rehabilitation works grew by 4.9%.

As regards building permits for new constructions, the Região Autónoma dos Açores also recorded the only declining rate of change (-6.9%) vis-à-vis the same period a year earlier. The remaining regions presented positive rates of change, more so the Região Autónoma da Madeira (+25.0%) and the Algarve (+23.6%). In what concerns permits for building rehabilitation, the Norte region presented a declining year-on-year rate of change (-4.5%) while the remaining regions recorded positive rates of change, with the emphasis on the Algarve (+53.6%) and Região Autónoma da Madeira (+44.8%), worth noting the increase, in both regions, in building enlargements.


In the 1st quarter 2019, the number of licensed dwellings in new constructions for family housing was 6.0 thousand, i.e. +29.6% compared to the 1st quarter 2018 (+51.0% in the 4th quarter 2018). All regions presented a positive rate of change in this indicator, with the emphasis on the Algarve (+85.4%), Região Autónoma dos Açores (+52.0%) and Área Metropolitana de Lisboa (+38.1%).

In Portugal, in the 1st quarter 2019, there was a year-on-year increase of 6.4% in the total licensed area. The Centro and Norte regions recorded the highest year-on-year declines in this variable: -2.0% and -0.6%, respectively. The remaining regions recorded positive rates of change, more so Área Metropolitana de Lisboa (+32.0%), the Alentejo (+28.9%) and the Algarve (+26.6%).

In the 1st quarter 2019, when focusing the analysis on a municipality level, the five municipalities with the highest absolute variation in the total number of licensed dwellings (considering all types of works and purposes) were responsible for the licensing of 22.4% of the total dwellings.

Thus, the municipalities that contributed the most to the absolute variation in the total number of licensed dwellings were Braga (17.9% of the total variation), Lisboa (14.2%), Vila Nova de Famalicão (8.7%), Albufeira (7.7%) and Guimarães (6.4%).

2. Completed buildings

In the 1st quarter 2019, the total number of completed buildings (new constructions, building enlargements, renovations and reconstructions) increased by 7.2% vis-à-vis the 1st quarter 2018 (+18.8% in the 4th quarter 2018). In this period, it is estimated that 3.7 thousand buildings were completed in Portugal, mostly corresponding to new constructions (73.4%) of which 73.3% were destined to become family housing.

The regions of Norte and of Alentejo presented declining year-on-year rates of change as completed buildings: -2.1% and -0.6%, respectively. The remaining regions recorded positive rates of change more so Área Metropolitana de Lisboa (+48.5%), Região Autónoma dos Açores (+44.7%) and Região Autónoma da Madeira (+16.4%).

In Portugal, completed works for new constructions increased by 8.2% when compared to the 1st quarter 2018 and rehabilitation works grew by 4.6%. In comparison with the previous quarter, completed works for new constructions decreased by 7.9% while rehabilitation works declined by 9.0%.

As regards completed works for new constructions, there were declining year-on-year rates of change in the regions of the Algarve (-15.6%) and Alentejo (-4.3%). The remaining regions presented positive year-on-year rates of change, with the emphasis on the Área Metropolitana de Lisboa (+51.3%) and Região Autónoma dos Açores (+48.1%).

In what concerns completed works for rehabilitation, the Norte region was the only one presenting a declining year-on-year rate of change (-10.0%). The highest positive rates of change were recorded in the Algarve (+43.8%), Área Metropolitana de Lisboa (+39.8%) and Região Autónoma dos Açores (+37.1%).

In the 1st quarter 2019, the number of completed dwellings in new constructions for family housing stood at 3.0 thousand, increasing by 8.4% when compared with the 1st quarter 2018 (+26.0% in the 4th quarter 2018). With the exception of the Centro (-9.6%) and of the Alentejo with a nil variation, the remaining regions presented positive year-on-year rates of change, more so the Região Autónoma da Madeira (+53.8%, i.e. 21 more dwellings) and Área Metropolitana de Lisboa (+38.7%, i.e. +188 dwellings).


Of the total buildings completed in the 1st quarter 2019, 66.6% were located in the regions of the Norte and Centro, where 60.6% of the total completed dwellings in new constructions for family housing in the country were located. The Norte region accounted for a 37.3% share in buildings and 35.2% in completed dwellings. The works completed in Área Metropolitana de Lisboa corresponded to 14.2% of the total buildings and 22.4% of the total dwellings in the country.

In the 1st quarter 2019, there was a 14.1% increase in the total completed construction area in Portugal. With the exception of the Alentejo, which recorded a declining rate of change (-4.9%), all other regions grew in terms of total construction area compared to the same period a year earlier. Região Autónoma da Madeira, Área Metropolitana de Lisboa, and Região Autónoma dos Açores were the regions with the largest relative increases: +76.0%, +35.3%, and +28.6%, respectively.

EXPLANATORY NOTES:

Building Permits

The goal behind this statistical operation is the gathering of data enabling to follow the evolution of the building construction sector, in a perspective of future starts in building construction. Data disseminated in this press release are based on the monthly permits issued by the 308 Municipalities across the country, under the scope of the Indicators System of Urban Operations (SIOU).

Estimates on Completed Works - Methodological note

Data on Completed Works are based on a methodology that allows a quarterly dissemination of estimated data subject to the least possible deviation consisting of an estimation of the deadline for the conclusion of a building based on the previewed deadline (i.e., the time elapsed between the permission to build and the effective conclusion of the building, stated in the permit), based on a linear regression model, according to the different types and final use of the buildings.

Quarter-on-quarter change rate

The quarter-on-quarter rate of change compares the level of each variable with the quarter immediately before.

Year-on-year change rate

The year-on-year rate of change compares the level of each variable between the current period and the same period a year earlier. On this press release, the year-on-year change rate of data related to building permits presents revisions on both buildings and dwellings, following the corrections sent by the Municipalities.
