Statistical Yearbook of Portugal: the 2019 edition is already available

The Statistical Yearbook of Portugal, a benchmark publication of Statistics Portugal, is now available in a renewed edition making it possible for quick access to reading highlighted data.

The dissemination date of the Statistical yearbook has been anticipated by six months compared to the previous edition, referring to data available up to 14 June 2019.

The Statistical yearbook of Portugal celebrates its 110th edition

The current edition of the [Statistical Yearbook of Portugal \(SYB\)](#) marks its 110th edition, having been published for the first time in 1877 with data referring to 1875.

The SYB 2018 is organized in 28 sub-chapters, grouped into four major themes (Territory, People, Economic Activity, and State) with data referring up to 14 June 2019.

This edition presents a statistical analysis introducing each subchapter, now summarized and illustrated by infographics for a quicker and more focused perception of the highlighted data.

All the statistical data contained in the SYB are also available at www.ine.pt in XLS/CSV format tables ready for download, which allows the access to long statistical time series with a geographical breakdown by NUTS I and

II levels, allowing for broader chronological and geographical comparisons.

The statistical indicators presented on the tables of each subchapter have hyperlinks to access the dissemination database of Statistics Portugal, updated on a regular basis which allows the consultation of the most recent data as well as methodological notes.

With the goal of promoting statistical literacy among younger generations and citizenship in general, the SYB 2018 is offered to public and private secondary schools libraries, as well as to all municipal libraries in the country.

The SYB is available in paper and digital format (PDF), in a bilingual (Portuguese/English) edition. At www.ine.pt, in the publications menu, all SYB editions since 2001 are available. Previous editions, beginning in 1877, are available through the digital library.
