




Construction: Building permits and completed buildings 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter 2019 – Preliminary data

# Building permits increased by 5.9% and completed buildings grew by 16.7%

**In the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter 2019**, the number of building permits was 5.7 thousand which stood for an increase of 5.9% compared to the same period of the previous year, accelerating vis-à-vis the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2019 (+1.9%). Building permits for new constructions increased by 6.2% and rehabilitation permits grew by 3.9% (+3.2% and -11.3% respectively, in the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2019). Completed buildings increased by 16.7% (+19.4% in the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2019) and amounted to 4.1 thousand buildings.

**When compared to the preceding quarter**, the number of building permits decreased by 2.5% (-5.4% in the  $2^{nd}$  quarter 2019) and the number of completed buildings increased by 5.3% (+4.3% in the  $2^{nd}$  quarter 2019).

In the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter 2019, there were 5.7 thousand building permits and 4.1 thousand completed buildings in Portugal. Building permits increased by 5.9% vis-à-vis the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter 2018 (+1.9% in the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2019), corresponding to a decrease of 2.5% when compared to the preceding quarter. Completed buildings increased by 16.7% in year-on-year terms (+19.4% in the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2019) and grew by 5.3% vis-à-vis the preceding quarter.

### 1. Building permits

In the  $3^{rd}$  quarter 2019, the number of building permits issued in Portugal was 5.7 thousand, corresponding to a 5.9% growth vis-à-vis the  $3^{rd}$  quarter 2018 (+1.9% in the  $2^{nd}$  quarter 2019).

Of the overall building permits, 69.4% corresponded to new constructions and, of these, 76.4% referred to family housing. Demolished buildings (492 units) corresponded to 8.6% of the total building permits in the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter 2019.

The Centro region was the only region presenting a decline in terms of the total number of buildings permits (-0.4%). The remaining regions presented positive rates of change compared to the same period a year earlier, more so the Alentejo (+17.9%), Algarve (+11.7%) and Área Metropolitana de Lisboa (+8.2%).

The number of building permits for new constructions in Portugal increased by 6.2% vis-à-vis the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter 2018 while rehabilitation works grew by 3.9%. When compared to the previous quarter, permits for new constructions decreased by 2.0% while rehabilitation works increased by 1.0%.

The building permits for new constructions recorded a negative rate of change compared to the same period of the previous year in Região Autónoma dos Açores (-2.9%). The remaining regions presented positive year-on-year rates of change, more so Região Autónoma da Madeira (+12.5%), Centro (+9.8%) and Área Metropolitana de Lisboa (+8.8%). In what concerns permits for building rehabilitation, the Centro region recorded a negative rate of change (-9.6%, corresponding to 36 less buildings), while Região Autónoma da Madeira recorded a nil variation. All the remaining regions recorded positive rates of change, with the emphasis on the Alentejo (+67.1%; +47 buildings) and Algarve (+15.4%; +12 buildings).

In the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter 2019, the number of licensed dwellings in new constructions for family housing was 6.1 thousand, corresponding to a 29.2% increase vis-à-vis the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter 2018 (+0.6% in the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2019). The Região Autónoma dos Açores was the only region to presented a negative rate of change compared to the same period a year earlier (-3.1%). The largest increases were recorded in the Algarve (+51.5%), Área Metropolitana de Lisboa (+37.4%) and in the Norte region (+33.9%).


In Portugal, in the  $3^{rd}$  quarter 2019, there was a year-on-year decrease (-2.1%) in the total licensed area. The regions of the Algarve, Região Autónoma da Madeira, Área Metropolitana de Lisboa and Centro recorded the highest year-on-year increases in this variable: +32.6%, +11.3%, +10.1% and +1.0%, respectively. The remaining regions recorded negative rates of change, with the emphasis on the Alentejo (-16.9%).





## Buildings and dwellings permits – Quarterly year-on-year change rate

(3<sup>rd</sup> quarter 2019)



In the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter 2019, when focusing the analysis on a municipality level, the five municipalities with the highest absolute variation vis-à-vis the same quarter of the previous year in terms of the total number of licensed dwellings (considering all types of works and purposes) were responsible for the licensing of 18.1% of the total dwellings.

### 2. Completed buildings

In the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter 2019, the total number of completed buildings (new constructions, building enlargements, renovations and reconstructions) increased by 16.7% compared to the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter 2018 (+19.4% in the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2019). In this period, it is estimated that 4.1 thousand buildings were completed in Portugal, mostly corresponding to new constructions (73.9%) of which 75.4% were meant to become family housing.

The Região Autónoma dos Açores presented a declining year-on-year rate of change as regards completed buildings: -21.3%. The remaining regions recorded positive year-on-year rates of change, more so Região Autónoma da Madeira (+57.1%) and Área Metropolitana de Lisboa (+51.5%).

In Portugal, completed works for new constructions increased by 14.9% when compared to the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter 2018 and rehabilitation works grew by 22.0%. Completed works for new constructions increased by 8.2% and rehabilitation works decreased by 2.0% in comparison with the previous quarter.

As regards completed works for new constructions, the only region that recorded a declining year-on-year rate of change was Região Autónoma dos Açores (-21.8%). All the remaining regions presented positive year-on-year rates of change, with the emphasis on Região Autónoma da Madeira (+55.0%), Área Metropolitana de Lisboa (+54.8%) and the Algarve (+29.4%).

In what concerns completed works for rehabilitation, the Região Autónoma dos Açores was the only one presenting a declining year-on-year rate of change (-20.4%; -11 buildings). The highest positive rates of change were recorded in Região Autónoma da Madeira (+60.9%; +14 buildings) and in Alentejo (+50.0%; +32 buildings).

In the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter 2019, the number of completed dwellings in new constructions for family housing stood at 3.8 thousand, increasing by 17.2% when compared to the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter 2018 (+14.6% in the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2019). There were only two regions that presented negative year-on-year rates of change: Região Autónoma dos Açores (-35.4%; -40 dwellings) and Região Autónoma da Madeira (-6.4%; -5 dwellings). All the remaining regions presented positive year-on-year rates of change, more so the Algarve (+72.6%) and Área Metropolitana de Lisboa (+34.2%), in line with the evolution in building permits.


Of the total buildings completed in the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter 2019, 65.4% were located in the regions of the Norte and Centro, where 60.9% of the total completed dwellings in new constructions for family housing in the country were located. The Norte region accounted for a 38.4% share in buildings and 38.1% in completed dwellings. The works completed in Área Metropolitana de Lisboa corresponded to 14.9% of the total buildings and 21.6% of the total dwellings in the country.

In the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter 2019, there was a 19.4% increase in the total completed construction area in Portugal. There were declining rates of change in Região Autónoma dos Açores (-26.7%), Região Autónoma da Madeira (-12.6%) and in the Centro (-10.5%). The remaining regions registered increases in terms of the total completed construction area compared to the same quarter of the previous year, with the emphasis on the Algarve, Alentejo and Norte regions (+63.4%, +42.8% and +39.0%, respectively).

#### **EXPLANATORY NOTES:**

### **Building Permits**

The goal behind this statistical operation is the gathering of data enabling to follow the evolution of the building construction sector, in a perspective of future starts in building construction. Data disseminated in this press release are based on the monthly permits issued by the 308 Municipalities across the country, under the scope of the Indicators System of Urban Operations (SIOU).

### Estimates on Completed Works – Methodological note

Data on Completed Works are based on a methodology that allows a quarterly dissemination of estimated data subject to the least possible deviation consisting of an estimation of the deadline for the conclusion of a building based on the previewed deadline (i.e., the time elapsed between the permission to build and the effective conclusion of the building, stated in the permit), based on a linear regression model, according to the different types and final use of the buildings.

#### Quarter-on-quarter change rate

The quarter-on-quarter rate of change compares the level of each variable with the quarter immediately before.

#### Year-on-year change rate

The year-on-year rate of change compares the level of each variable between the current period and the same period a year earlier. On this press release, the year-on-year change rate of data related to building permits presents revisions on both buildings and dwellings, following the corrections sent by the Municipalities.
