
## Business and Consumer Surveys July 2007

## The Consumer confidence indicator and the climate indicator declined slightly

The Consumer confidence indicator declined moderately in July, discontinuing the recovery of the two previous months.

In July the economic climate indicator also got slightly worse, interrupting the upward trend started in October 2005, after reaching in June the maximum of the five previous years.

In Manufacturing Industry, the confidence indicator deteriorated in July, contradicting the upward trend observed since June 2006. In Trade, the confidence indicator got worse in the last three months. Similarly to what happened in June, this movement was observed in both retail trade and wholesale in July. In Services, this indicator showed a deterioration in the last two months, suspending the upward trend started in August 2005. In Construction and Public Works, the confidence indicator stabilized, suspending the upward trend that begun in January.
