



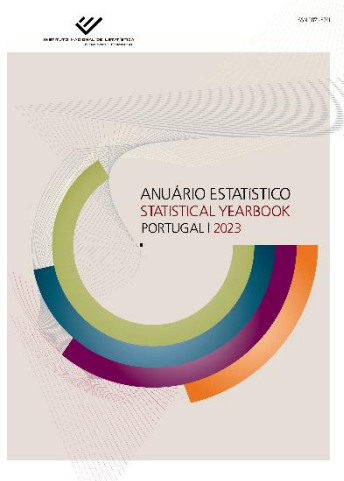

## STATISTICAL YEARBOOK OF PORTUGAL 2023 NOW AVAILABLE

The latest Statistical Yearbook of Portugal is now available, a compendium of official statistical information that brings together in a single volume a statistical portrait of the country in various domains.

The information in the 2023 yearbook generally refers to the data available on 14 June 2024, and presents in each chapter a synthetic statistical analysis and a series of infographics that allow a quick understanding of the phenomena highlighted.



### STATISTICAL YEARBOOK OF PORTUGAL 2023

The Statistical Yearbook of Portugal 2023 is the 115<sup>th</sup> edition of this collection. The first volume was published in 1877 under the title 'Anuário Estatístico do Reino de Portugal 1875' (Statistical Yearbook of the Kingdom of Portugal 1875), with the aim of presenting the territory, population and economy through statistics.

This yearbook is divided into four main themes (The Territory, The People, The Economic Activity and The State) and 29 chapters, each of which presents a summary analysis and a series of infographics that give the reader a quick overview of demographic, social and economic phenomena. The data presented in this edition generally refer to 14 June 2024.

The Statistical Yearbook of Portugal adopts the new territorial configuration called NUTS 2024. This new territorial nomenclature results from the entry into force of Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2023/674 of 26 September 2022 which, in the case of Portugal, introduces three new divisions at NUTS 2 level: Grande Lisboa, Península de Setúbal, Oeste e Vale do Tejo. At NUTS 3 level, 5 new divisions have been added: Grande Lisboa, Península de Setúbal, Oeste, Lezíria do Tejo e Médio Tejo.

STATISTICAL YEARBOOK OF PORTUGAL – 2023



This yearbook is a bilingual publication (Portuguese and English). It is published on paper and in electronic form, available on the Statistics Portugal website ([www.ine.pt](http://www.ine.pt)) in PDF format (analyses and graphs), accompanied by the corresponding statistical tables (XLSX and CSV formats) with extended time series and geographical breakdown at NUTS 1 and 2 level, allowing greater comparability over time and geography. An HTML version is also available for consultation on any device using a browser.

As usual, the indicators in the subchapters are linked to Statistics Portugal's dissemination database, which is regularly updated. Thus, with each new consultation, the user will always have access to the most recent data provided by Statistics Portugal. The link also allows you to consult the associated metadata.

With the aim of promoting citizenship and statistical literacy among citizens and students, the Statistical Yearbook of Portugal continues to be offered to municipal libraries throughout the country, as well as to secondary school libraries (public and private) and university libraries.
