1. Framework

This report is prepared in compliance with the provisions on cooperation and collaboration set out in Article 7(3) of Decree-Law No. 109-E/2021 of 9 December, in conjunction with the provisions of Article 17 of Law No. 93/2021 of 20 December, which transposes Directive (EU) 2019/1937 on the protection of persons who report breaches of Union law.

Statistics Portugal is the central body responsible for the production and dissemination of official statistics in Portugal, ensuring the supervision and technical-scientific coordination of the National Statistical System, within a framework of technical and professional independence. Statistics Portugal's activities are carried out within a national and European legal framework, which includes, in particular, the Organic Law of Statistics Portugal (Decree-Law No. 136/2012 of 2 July), Regulation (EC) No. 223/2009, as amended by Regulation (EU) 2015/759, and the European Statistics Code of Practice (2017 edition). Statistics Portugal is a public institute under a special legal regime, with legal personality and administrative autonomy, under the authority of the Minister of the Presidency. It operates throughout the national territory, with headquarters in Lisbon and offices in Porto, Coimbra, Évora and Faro.

In this report, Statistics Portugal presents the data relating to communications received through Statistics Portugal's Whistleblowing Channel in 2024, namely:
