Information and Communication Technologies Usage in Enterprises

82% of enterprises with ten and more employed persons accessed to the internet via broadband

The results of a survey on Information and Communication Technologies Usage in Enterprises reveal that, in 2009, 95,3% of enterprises with ten and more employed persons had used computer and 92,7% had access to the Internet. The Internet connections through broadband were used by 81,7% of the enterprises.

Information and Communication Technologies Usage

In 2009, 95,3% of enterprises with ten and more employed persons had used computer, 90,5% had communicated through e-mail and 92,7% had accessed the Internet.

The usage of these technologies varies in the same ratio of the enterprise size (measured by the employment¹). All the large enterprises (with 250 or more employed persons) had used computer, e-mail and had accessed to the Internet; in the medium-sized enterprises, 99,8% used computer, 99,6% used e-mail and 99,2% accessed to the Internet; in small enterprises (between 10 and 49 employed persons) the computer was used by 94,5%, the e-mail by 88,9% and the Internet by 91,6%.

Compared with the technologies discussed previously, the website possession has relatively minor expression: 47,3% of enterprises with ten and more employed persons claimed to have website, increasing the proportion to 94% when measured in the universe of the large enterprises.
