Industry Turnover, Employment, Wages and Hours worked Indexes March 2010

Year on year growth in industry turnover increases

Employment, wage and hours worked decreased

The turnover in the industry in nominal terms, presented an increase of 16.2%, 6.7 percentage points higher than in February mainly influenced by the behaviour of the foreign market. The sales to this market recorded an increase of 30.4% in March (12.8% in February) due in particular to the performance of the Energy industry.

The annual change in the 1st quarter of 2010 stood at 11.9% (-5.9% in the fourth quarter of 2009).

Employment, wages and hours worked (adjusted for calendar effects) decreased year on year, 4.0%, and 2.6% and 2.5%, respectively.
