The Danish Cawi experience

Abstract

Denmark has been collecting data via web-interviews since 2012. In this paper/presentation I wish to present some of our experiences with this mode of data collection.

My presentation will touch briefly on the Danish data collection for the EU-silc, response rates and the results of upcoming analysis on the quality and variance of answers in the self-administered web interviews, compared to the quality of answers from our CATI interviews. The analysis will focus mainly on analyzing the correlation between actual income, which we collect from our registers and the subjective measurements of poverty collected from our interviews. The analysis will also focus on variation between the two modes of data collection on self-reported health and well-being, corrected for factors such as income, labour market status, demographics and regional weather, at the time of the interview.
