



Francisco Vala holds a degree in Geography and regional planning by the University of Lisbon and a post graduation in Urban Studies by the same university. He has been working at Statistics Portugal since 2000 and he's currently the Director for the Coordination of Territorial Statistics. He is the Regional Statistics Co-ordination Officer for Eurostat, the Portuguese delegate in the OECD Working Party on Territorial Indicators and he is involved on the work developed by the UN-GGIM Europe working Group on Data integration.

At Statistics Portugal, he is responsible for the coordination of compilation, production, improvement and dissemination of local and regional statistics taking into account the needs for regional and local policy monitoring, including the Statistical Regional Yearbooks, the Regional Development Composite Index, the Study on Municipal Purchasing Power and the Territorial Portrait of Portugal. He is currently coordinating the working group in the Statistical Council dealing with the statistical indicators for the EU programming period 2014 – 2020.

From 2001 until 2014, he took the position of invited assistant at the Institute of Geography and Spatial Planning - University of Lisbon, lecturing Urban Geography, Economic Geography and Methods and Techniques in Geography. He was also a researcher in the Centre of Geographical Studies - University of Lisbon, and his research interests include urban studies, economic and social geography and methods and techniques using Geographical Information Systems.
