



Gunter Schäfer studied Industrial Engineering at the Technical University of Karlsruhe, Economic Sociology at the London School of Economics and Economics at the University of Cologne.

From 1980 until 1987, Gunter Schäfer was employed by an institute linked to the University of Cologne specialising in business analysis and IT research as well as management consultancy to private enterprises. In this function he was also technical manager of a large scale European project in the ESPRIT programme. In 1987, Gunter Schäfer joined the European Commission in the Informatics Directorate where he soon took over the project leadership for the

introduction of electronic mail and related services including the respective technical architecture for the entire Commission. In 1999, Gunter Schäfer joined Eurostat to coordinate short-term statistics particularly to support the economic policy in the newly created Euro Area. Later on he headed the dissemination unit of Eurostat and since 2009 the unit in charge of regional statistics and geographic information.
