



Oliver Heiden's background is in economics but he also studied political science, sociology and linguistics. From 2008 until 2014 he worked as a Statistical Officer at Eurostat. In the unit of Regional Statistics and Geographical Information he was responsible for managing the regular comitology procedures for updating the European classification of NUTS regions, oversaw the local data production, and took over the project leadership for establishing EU Harmonised Labour Market Areas.

In 2014, Oliver Heiden joined the European Committee of the Regions to collaborate closer with politicians as well as key representatives of EU institutions, international organisations, NGOs and associations on the remits of the COTER commission such as Cohesion Policy, Transport and EU budget.

He is administrator in charge of the recently adopted CoR opinion on 'Indicators for territorial development – GDP and beyond' and supports the CoR's contribution to the European Statistical Advisory Committee (ESAC).
