Summary

This proposal is the second framework regulation envisaged within the strategy on agricultural statistics for 2020 and beyond, endorsed by the European

Statistical System Committee in November 2015, complementing the framework Regulation (EU) 2018/1091 on Integrated Farm Statistics.

The proposal establishes a common framework for aggregated European statistics related to the inputs and outputs of agricultural activities, as well as the intermediate use of such output within agriculture and its collection and industrial processing. It covers agricultural production (crops and animals) as well as organic farming, agri-environmental statistics on issues such as fertilizers, nutrient balances and plant protection products, and agricultural prices.

The main aim of the Commission's initiative is to monitor and evaluate the Common Agricultural Policy (CAP) and other important EU policies, and to support policy-making. This proposal also aims to streamline and update agricultural statistics legislation, to reduce the burden to provide data by using various sources of information and modern technology, to take account of new data needs and to ensure better comparability of collected data.
